#### **1. Overall**

1.1 The rules and regulations "Open Kennemerland" will apply during the tournament.

1.2 When unforeseen circumstances, which are not provided in the Regulations, the tournament organisation take the necessary decisions, and they are always irreversible.

#### **2. Tournament Information**

2.2 The various tournaments held during Open Kennemerland "are the following: Single tournament for girls, cadets, juniors, ladies and gentlemen and depending on the number of participants. In the event of insufficient registrations in girls, the tournament organisation to decide the age at the junior or aspirants to share.

#### **3. Participation justice**

3.1 All members or a member of the DVK and / or NDB participate in "Open Kennemerland "excluding suspended members of the DVK.

#### **4. Registration**

4.1 Registration for the tournament "Open Kennemerland" is only possible through an online registration. This online registration is available at:

4.2 Participation is only possible after registration. The closing of the tenders will be determined by the organisation.

4.3 Bids received after the deadline will not be accepted.

4.4 The entry fee for the single ladies and gentlemen is 10 Euros. Registration fee for participation in youth is 5 euro.

4.5 The charge for tenders is legally required to have entry fees of the players or players that he / she enrolled to pay.

4.6 Entry fee is the charge by the date specified in the the state to receive e-mail, to be met.

4.7 Until the registration fee by the controller has not been met, attached remain excluded from participation.

4.8 In exceptional circumstances, the manner and timing of payment agreed to that organisation. That you or at the time of registration with the body.

#### **5. Tournaments**

5.1 "Open Kennemerland" no other tournaments will take place over The singles tournaments in the discipline, girls, cadets, juniors, ladies and gentlemen.

5.2 The tournament will be single women, men, girls / boy's youth contain. From the age of 8 years must be at the youth. From the age of 18 years, the girls and boys in the ladies / men's single to participate. From the age of 16 years or dispensation based on talent, boys and girls may register for single ladies and gentlemen.

#### **6. Draw**

6.1 Following the closing of the tender will draw for the tournament as soon as may be performed. None of the organisation and / or tournament management may be held responsible for possible changes and / or additions to these lists.

#### **7. Dress code**

7.1 Players will be dressed as neat as possible for all matches. Sportswear and shorts are not permitted.

7.2 Players must have a shirt with a collar to wear. There are no T-shirts allowed unless they discreetly worn under a shirt with a collar. Shirts of football clubs are not allowed.

#### **8. Smoking and drinking**

8.1 In all accommodations there is a smoking ban.

8.2 In the section of the hall where the tournament is held, clearly defined and identified, there will be a total ban on food and drinks for players and spectators.

8.3 Players who violate the previous rule will be taken out of the tournament.

#### **9. Registration**

9.1 All tournament players shall register at the darts event at scheduled times, which are predetermined by the organisation

9.2 Any tournament player failing to register by the notified time shall be eliminated from that respective tournament, in which instance no entry fee shall be refundable.

9.3 If the board is free on your race, the participant is not notification has to be taken out of game. Any player that is not in attendance when called upon to play at the nominated time shall forfeit that leg, set, or match, whichever is applicable; in such instances no entry fee shall be refundable.

9.4 A game can start if the board is free for the game and all parties are present for this game.

9.5 The tournament organisation is allowed to move a game to another board.

#### **10. Lane Letter**

10.1 For each match in the competition will contest a table formatted note with the lane number and the names of the players mentioned them.

10.2 The author / referee is responsible for the correct results that are listed on the note after finishing a match race.

10.3 The winner of a match will match the completed letter with his / her results checked and bring the result immediately to the game table.

#### **11. Game Format**

11.1 Singles are played in the format best of 501 ....

11.2 The young girls played in the best of 5 legs to the semi finals. The final will be played in best of 7 legs.

11.3 The boys played youth is in the best of 5 legs to the last 8. The Quarterfinals and semi-finals will be played in best of 7 legs and the final in the best of 9 legs.

11.4 The ladies singles will be played in best of 5 legs to the last 32. The last 16 and quarterfinals will be played in best of 7 legs. The semi-final is played in the best of 9 legs and the final in the best of 3 sets, best of 5 legs per set.

11.5 The men's singles will be played from 256 to the last 16 in the best of 7 legs. The last 16 and quarterfinals will be played in the best of 9 legs. The semi finals will be played in best of 3 sets, best of 5 legs per set and the final in the best of 5 sets, best of 5 legs per set.

#### **12. Order of play**

12.1 The order of play will be determined by throwing the 'Bull'. In a single tournament, the first player in the game which is first on the note starts to the 'Bull' with one dart. Followed by the second player

12.2 If the arrow of the first player is in the '25 'or the' Bull ', the opponent has the choice to leave the arrow in the board or to get it out.

12.3 when the marker can't determine which darts is the closest to the 'Bull' or when both darts are in the 25 or 'Bull". The players have to throw again and this time the second player starts.

12.4 The player closest to the centre of the dartboard throwing, will first throw in the first leg and the subsequent odd legs. If played in sets, he / she will start the first leg of the first set and then start the first leg of the odd sets.

#### **13. Writing**

13.1 A player who has won his / her game has the obligation to mark the next match, unless the organisation decides otherwise.

13.2 The designated marker may find a replacement for the next game, but remains fully responsible for the marking contest. The original marker needs to inform the organisation.

13.2 If a player fails to meet the writing requirement, or fails to find a replacement, he / she will be taken out of the tournament and have no right to prize money, prizes or trophies.

#### **14. Prize money**

14.1 Before Open Kennemerland starts, the organisation shows the prize money on the site.

14.2 For the girls and boys youth, prizes will be paid in vouchers.

14.3 After the completion of a full round where there were prizes, the prize can be picked up at the tournament organisation table.

14.4 In order to retrieve the prize, the participants need to be in the possession of a legitimate identity.

14.5 Prizes that are not collected or the collector can not show any personal details, than the prize money will not be paid out and remain to the property of the organisation and will not be paid out.

14.6 Players who fail to fulfil their obligations by not match their prescribed throwing competitions, including the finale, will be entitled to any prize, prizes or trophies for the specific loss component.

#### **15. Prize giving**

15.1 After the finals of the boy's youth, there will be a ceremony for the first 4 girls and boys. After the final of the men's single, there will be a ceremony for the final 4 ladies and gentlemen.

15.2 not present at the award ceremony will no longer entitled to the prizes and / or trophies.

#### **16. Conduct.**

16.1 Any form of misconduct and / or drunkenness will inevitably lead to direct exclusion from "Open Kennemerland" participant and will also no longer entitled to any prize money earned and / or trophies. In which instance no entry fee shall be refundable.
